



Los Angeles General Medical Center (LAGMC) Metrolink Infill Station Project

Overview

Metro has a plan to make it easier to get around, which includes projects to improve transit access across LA County. The LAGMC Infill Station Project will improve regional rail access along the Metrolink San Bernardino Line by adding a new station near one of the largest public hospitals in the United States.

The LAGMC Infill Station will be located adjacent to the LAGMC Bus Station on the El Monte Busway, with direct access to Pomeroy Avenue and the surrounding neighborhood. The station area is home to a high concentration of essential workers, patients, and local businesses, and currently faces significant traffic congestion and limited transit access.

A Feasibility Study completed in July 2022 evaluated the potential for the new station to improve mobility, reduce parking demand, and support the transformation of the medical center area into a thriving health innovation district. The station would enhance regional rail connections to Downtown Los Angeles and beyond.

Proposed Project

Metro is advancing plans to construct a new center platform station along the existing Metrolink San Bernardino Line. The project includes a grade-separated pedestrian bridge with stairs and an elevator, along with one at-grade crossing to ensure safe and convenient passenger access to the platform.

The project aims to improve transit access for essential workers and daily visitors to the LAGMC campus, enhance mobility across Los Angeles County, reduce the strain on local roads and parking infrastructure, and provide air quality benefits.

Metro is currently initiating environmental studies ahead of final design and construction, with early design work expected to reach 30% completion by early 2026.

California Environmental Quality Act

To comply with CEQA, Metro is completing technical studies of the proposed LAGMC Infill Station Project. These studies focus on air quality, noise and vibration, historic resources, hazardous materials, and traffic impacts.

Project Funding

This current phase of the project for the environmental studies and preliminary engineering design is funded with LA Metro local Measure R sales tax dollars.
